Mission Statement:

**Program Intended

- 2. Demonstrate proficiency in teaching

**Assessment Method and
Criteria:**

- 1. Department proficiency examination
- 2a. Praxis II
- 2b. Course-based exhibitions
- 2c. Student teaching portfolio
- 2d. Judgments from field-based supervisors

Assessment Results:

- 1. Candidates must pass department exam.
- 2a. Candidates must pass Praxis II
- 2b. Students submit high-quality plans in EDSE 4125 and EDSE 4126.
- 2c. Students submit high-quality plans during student teaching that are consistent with INTASC principles.
- 2d. Judged as proficient or better
