# CSU Libraries 2002-2003

**Program Intended**

**Outcomes:**

- 1a. Embrace the teaching library model by getting librarians more involved in teaching information literacy
- 1b. Improve the libraries' collections
- 1c. Improve and expand services to users
- 1d. Provide opportunities for staff development that will enable staff to work more efficiently and effectively, thus being more helpful and useful to students.
- 1e. Enhance instructional technology for the entire campus.

**Assessment Method and**

**Criteria:**

- 1a. Monitor the number of classes (credit and course-related) taught by librarians
- 1b1. Compare annual statistics by LC class numbers.
- 1b2. Ask users to rate their satisfaction re: collections on an annual user survey.
- 1c. Ask users to rate their satisfaction re: services on an annual user survey.
- 1d 1. Monitor the number of workshops, conferences etc. attended by staff.
- 1d 2. Ask users to rate their satisfaction with staff assistance on an annual user survey.
- 1e. Analyze figures for ITS efforts in the provision of classroom and presentation technology.

**Assessment Results:**

- 1a. FY03: 133 BI sessions were taught to 2571 students; 5 credit course sections w/ 93 students.
- 1b1. The collection grew by 1%. Music had a 7% growth rate. Art and Lit. grew by 1%.
- 1b2. A user survey was not conducted in FY03.
- 1c. A user survey was not conducted in FY03.
- 1d 1. The number of workshops attended by staff was down due to budget cuts..
- 1d 2. A user survey was not conducted in FY03.
- 1e. 5 media classroom were added and 6 were upgraded.

**Use of Results:**

- 1a. Number of BI sessions increased 25% since FY02; number of students, 16%. Credit course sections increased by 25%; reached 3% more students. Hired a Coordinator of Instruction.
- 1b1. Will continue to place a emphasis on music. Will look at low growth areas & explore formula funding.
- 1b2. A survey will be conducted in FY04.
- 1c. A user survey will be conducted in FY04.
- 1d1. Will seek to improve funding in FY04.
- 1d2. A user survey will be conducted in FY04.
- 1e. Lobby for more staff to install and maintain media classrooms

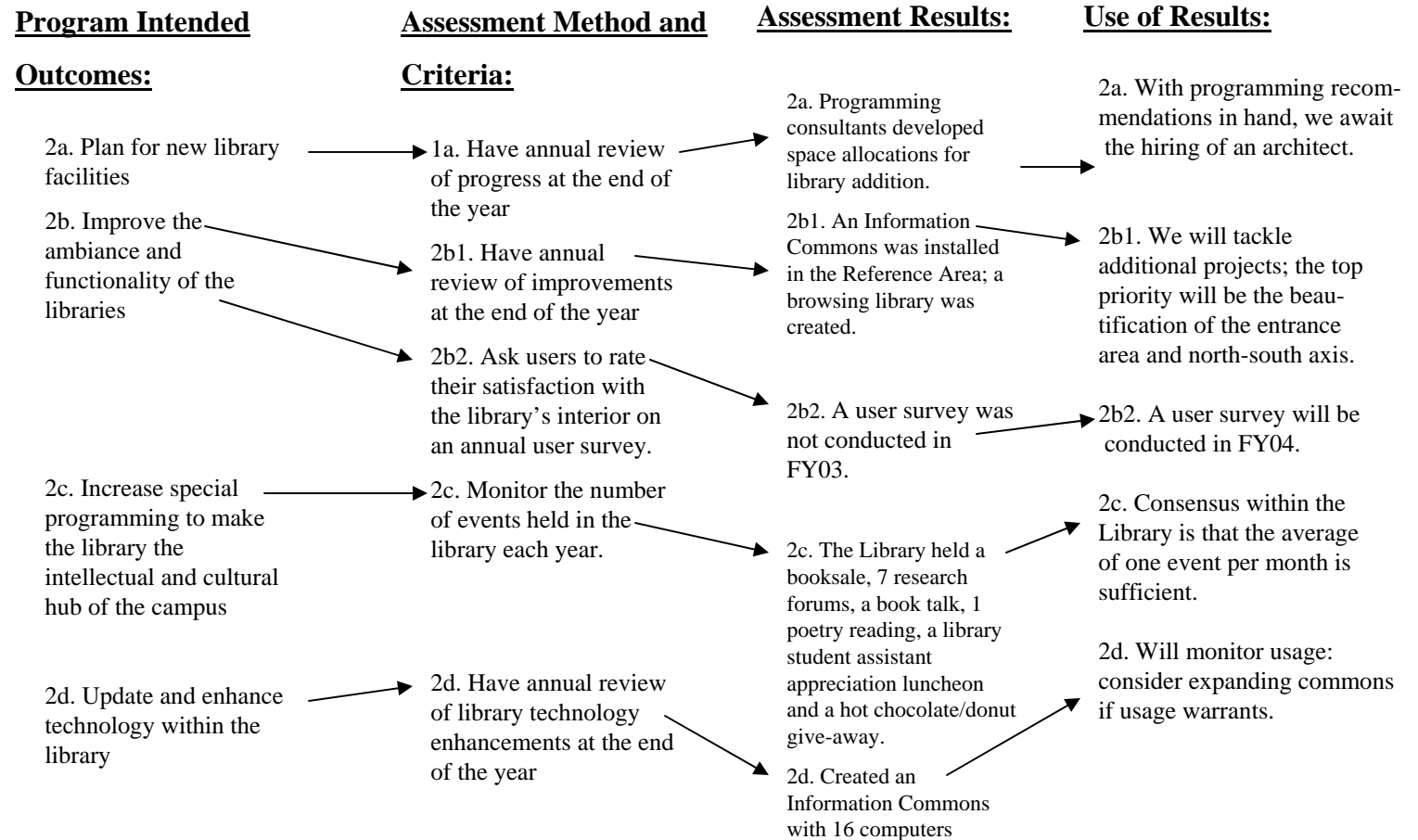
