Their EdS programs were completed in 4-5 semesters of continual enrollment from Fall 2005.</p> <p>With the GRE requirement no longer a factor in EdS admission, it is anticipated that more CSU Middle Grades MEd completers will return to enroll in the EdS program. For Summer 2007 Graduate Orientation, 8 Middle Grades EdS students were admitted to the program, 3 of whom (27%) had earned CSU MEd degrees.</p>
